Year 2 have been studying *Where The Wild Things Are*. At Forest School they have used tools and natural resources to make miniature boats or rafts to sail across our pond. They have also been to Furzefield Wood to enjoy a 'wild rumpus'.

Following their theatre trip to see Mr. Bloom, reception children have been preparing vegetable beds and sowing seeds. We have sowed broad bean and carrot seeds and watching them germinate inside ready to plant out after Easter. We have planted seed potatoes.



Years 5 and 6 have been enjoying Forest School with Miss Hutchings: designing and making a water station using string, scissors and a plastic water bottle; creating a birds eye representation of the Forest School area and making human skeletons out of natural materials. All of these activities focussed on working as a team to solve problems.
