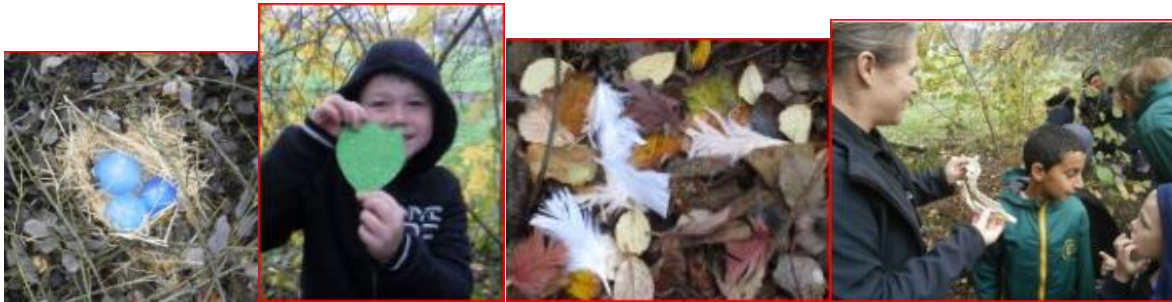


## Forest School News: December 18
