Starters for Science is a series of five-minute videos created to support children to get started with practical science enquiry.

They require minimal resources and can be used in school or at home.

Each video includes:

- A question or scenario related to the real world
- Time for children to think about what they already know
- A demonstration of a starter practical activity
- Time for children to think of their own questions
- Ideas about what they could find out for themselves
- Encouragement to share what they found with others

The videos are designed to get children doing some simple practical science experiments and are not age specific. They are intended to give children valuable practical experiences that they will then be able to draw on once they meet the relevant concepts in a more formal learning situation.
