Happy Summer Term

Dear Parents and Carers,

This term we will be looking at life cycles of various creatures and plants (butterfly, frog, ladybird, beans, sunflowers). We will be using fictional texts to support this learning (Very Hungry Caterpillar, Princess and Frog, The Tiny Seed etc).



We will continue to practice fine motor skills with knives, scissors, paper folding, pens etc. and writing our names/practicing letter formation.

In Mathematical Development we will be looking at addition and subtraction with the use of birthday candles, beans, frogs and vegetables, number formation, ordering numbers, accurate counting and capacity.



Our literacy will be focused hearing the first sound and end letter sounds in words and hearing rhyming strings.



The weather this summer, I'm sure will be unpredictable, so we will be looking at it as and when it changes in outside

environment. Please ensure your child has a waterproof coat and spare clothes in their bookbag.

As and when the sunny summer arrives, please make sure your child has had suntan lotion already applied and for clothing please can your child wear either:

Girls - yellow polo shirt, school black/green shorts, white socks, Velcro trainers and a named school jumper;
