

We will be continuing our topic of 'The ocean' and will be reading stories and poems linked to the

Keep reading daily and practise weekly spellings..

Maths

This term we will continue to work on our addition and subtraction skills focussing on mental calculations. We will also be working on measure, looking at time and length linked to our theme.

How you can help at home:

Practise mental addition and subtraction at home. Weekly Maths homework and mathletics.

Science

States of Matter; The children will be comparing and grouping materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases.

Sound; The children will be identifying how sounds are made, recognising that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear. Finding patterns between pitch of a sound and features of the object that it produced it.

<u>How you can help at home:</u> Identify sound spots, focussing on vibration and pitch.



Topic learning

This term the children will be learning about oceans and rivers and how they link together. After half term we will be learning about the Ancient Greeks. We will be learning about the ancient civilisation including their mythology.
