Maths: Please support your child in learning their times tables


Please remember to spend some time on Reading Eggs, Mathletics, and Times Table Rock stars.

Year Three
Autumn Term

English

We will be looking at story writing and linking it to rainforests.



We will also be looking at different types of poetry.

How you can help at home:

Please support your child with learning their spellings every week. They should also be including 5 reads a week in their reading record; it really will make a difference!

Reading eggs is another very useful way of supporting your child's learning.

Maths

This term we will be concentrating on place value, addition, and subtraction.



A key focus will be on the times tables and in Year three we start using the exciting maths incentive called Times Tables Rockstars

How you can help at home:

Please help teach them their times tables; chant them, sing them, say them!

Mathletics is another useful way of supporting your child's learning.

Your child have their logins for Mathletics and Times Table Rock Stars in their Reading Record.

Science

We will be learning about light and shadow before half term, and magnets and forces after half term. In both topics we will be conducting lots of investigating to help support the children's learning.

How you can help at home:

Encourage your child to talk about the day and night. Discuss different forms of light and shadows.

Talk about forces, friction, movement and magnets.



PSHE

We will be looking at the school values of cooperation and unity. We will also spend time learning about having a Growth Mindset and pay specific attention to starting year 3 and the transition from KS1 to KS2.

How you can help at home:

By supporting and implementing the school rules . By talking and sharing with your children.



Geography

We are learning about tropical rainforests and our class countries; Canada and the USA.

How you can help at home:

Look at an atlas and discuss how to use a map. Look up a route for a family walk.



Music

We will be using Surrey Arts Interactive to learn Musical theory based on the song ' Let your Spirit Fly'. We will also be learning body percussion and boom-whackers.



How you can help at home: Sing lots of different songs and talk about different music you may hear.

Computing

We will be developing basic computing skills in MS Word and PowerPoint and developing the children's programming skills.



How you can help at home:

Promote healthy computer habits, remind them about being safe on the internet, and let them try Purple Mash.

Art

Art will be linked to our class countries, our rainforest topic, science, and PSHE.



PE

Throughout this term we will be learning dance, yoga, orienteering, and football.



How you can help at home:

Our PE days are Tuesday and Friday. Pupils need to come to school in their PE kits.

RE

We will be looking at how people express belief through the arts, how the bible teaches us about God, and why presents are given at Christmas.
