Curriculum Information Ocean Centre / Year Three Autumn Term

English

This term our fiction and non-fiction writing will be linked to our class name - Ocean. We will be researching about the different oceans in the world and what lives in them and where. Stories will have a nautical theme and children will be learning how to write non-chronological reports, stories, play scripts and developing confidence and memory through drama. We will continue to work on hand-writing and spelling and children will read to an adult at least 3 times per week.

Maths

This term we will be concentrating on place value, addition and subtraction. We will also look at number patterns and multiplication as lots of and groups of and division as sharing. We will use measure in real life when cooking.



A key focus will be on the times tables and the school is continuing with the exciting maths incentive called the Mighty Multiples!

How you can help at home:

Please help teach them their times tables; chant them, sing them, say them!

Mathletics is another useful way of supporting your child's learning.

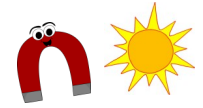
Science

We will be learning about light and shadow. Then we will be learning about magnets and forces. In both topics we will be conducting lots of experiments to help support the children's learning.

We will be looking at new beginnings, with specific attention to starting year 3.

Geography
