**English**

Please help teach them their times tables; chant them, sing them, say them!

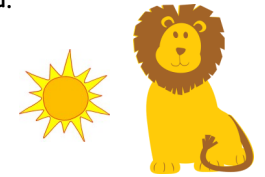
Mathletics is another useful way of supporting your child's learning.
