## Curriculum Information Year Five Summer Term

**English**

This term we will be learning all about film narrative, including 'The Piano' a fabulous piece of musical drama. We will be learning how to write non-chronological reports, instructions, play scripts and developing our confidence within drama. Additionally, we will be securing our understanding of vocabulary, sentence structure and the use of punctuation.

**Maths**

This term in Maths we will be developing our understanding and confidence when working with square, cube and prime numbers. We will also be learning about statistics; line graphs, tables and probability.

**Science**

This term in Science, we will be learning all about Forces. We will be identifying the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction. In the second part of the summer term, we will review life cycles and make links to our Health and Relationship topic—puberty.

Why not help us by exploring forces at home. Which will fall to the ground quicker? Why? How do you know?

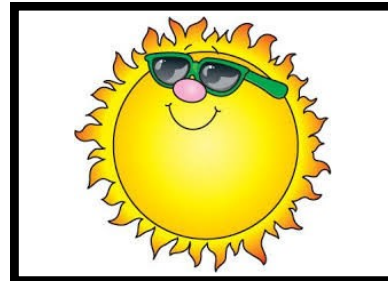
**History**

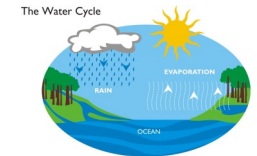
**How you can help at home:**
