**How you can help at home:**

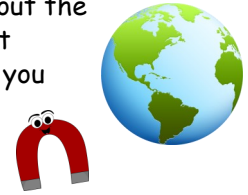
Please help teach them their times tables! Mathletics and TT RockStars are another useful way of supporting your child's learning.
